A morning run through the forests and along the coast of Suffolk with a stop at Snape Maltings.
Total distance 84 Miles, approximately 2.5 hours driving time with a 1.5 hour stop at Snape Maltings.

MEET POINT: Beacon Hill Services, A14 / A140 junction, West of Ipswich. IP6 8LP
Meet from 9.30am for 10.00am start.

FUEL: Fill up at Beacon Hill if you need it.

ROUTE SECTION 1. BEACON HILL TO SNAPE

		Zero trip when leaving the services
0.0	0.0	Turn left out of services onto slip road (zero trip here)
0.0	0.0	At roundabout take first exit Norwich A140
0.3	0.5	Turn right to Coddendam B1078. Note narrow bridge then 20mph speed limit in Coddendam!
2.2	3.5	Bear right in Coddendam continuing on B1078 up narrow hill
7.0	11.3	At T junction turn right, on B1079 to Woodbridge
7.6	12.2	In Clopton, keep right on the B1079
8.9	14.4	On right hand bend turn left to Debach (<i>nice sweeping bends with smooth tarmac</i>)
10.7	17.2	At T junction turn right to Dallinghoo (back onto the B1078)
15.6	25.1	In Wickham Market turn right at T junction towards town centre
18.2	29.3	In Ufford, just through village turn left to Melton B1438
19.5	31.4	In Melton, at bottom of hill just past Horse and Groom turn left to Bawdsey A1152
19.8	31.8	At T junction turn left to Bawdsey A1152
20.3	32.6	At roundabout take second exit to Bawdsey on A1083
24.2	39.0	In Shottisham, at T junction turn right to Bawdsey B1083
27.0	43.4	In Alderton, turn left in village at Post Office Stores into Hollesley Road
34.2	55.0	In Butley, at T junction turn right B1084
34.4	55.4	In Butley turn left into Wantisden
36.7	59.1	In Tunstall, at T junction turn right to Orford B1078 (<i>this is one of my favourites bits of Suffolk road</i>)
39.2	63.1	At T junction turn left to Sudbourne B1084
40.0	64.4	At T junction turn left to Sudbourne
44.1	71.0	At T junction turn right towards Aldeburgh
44.2	71.1	Arrive Snape Maltings Turn right into the site just past the pub, BEWARE OF THE SPEED HUMPS, THEY ARE EVIL! Be polite to the parking attendant if he is on duty, he is our friend. Follow the road right to the back of the site where we can park up on a grass area

Check out the two coffee shops or pub for morning coffee and tea

For the return journey please please be ready to leave about 1.5 hours after our arrival, at 1.00pm or stay on for the afternoon to enjoy Snape Maltings

ROUTE SECTION 2. SNAPE RETURNING TO BEACON HILL VIA ALDEBURGH

miles	km	
0.0	0.0	Turn right out of Snape Maltings (zero trip here)
1.1	1.8	At crossroads turn right A1094 to Aldeburgh
5.5	8.9	In Aldeburgh, at roundabout take third exit to town centre A1094
5.9	9.5	At crossroads continue straight over then at T junction on sea front then turn left
9.7	15.6	In Aldringham, at junction turn right and immediately left to Knodishall B1353
10.2	16.4	At T junction turn right to Leiston B1069
11.3	18.2	In Leiston at traffic lights turn left to Saxmundham B1119
15.3	24.6	In Saxmundham at traffic lights continue straight over to Framlingham B1119
15.6	25.1	At T junction turn left to Framlingham B1119
16.0	25.7	At junction with A12 dual carriageway turn right then immediately left to Framlingham B1119
22.6	36.4	In Framlingham at T junction turn right signed "all other routes"
22.8	36.7	At mini roundabout take first exit signed "all other routes"
25.5	41.0	In Dennington at T junction turn left to Stowmarket A1120
29.8	48.0	In Earl Soham turn left to Stowmarket continuing on the A1120
34.5	55.5	In Petaugh take the second left to Stowmarket continuing on the A1120
37.7	60.7	At cross roads turn left to Ipswich A140
40.4	65.0	SPEED CAMERA ON DUAL CARRIAGE WAY NEAR BOTTOM OF HILL 50 MPH!
40.9	65.8	At roundabout take third exit returning back up A140 then immediately left in to services
40.2	64.7	Arrive back at Beacon Hill Services. We made it!

Beacon Hill has a Little Chef and Burger King with various pubs within a few miles

That's it, my final run as Eastern Region Area Coordinator, through some of my favourites bits of Suffolk, I hope you enjoyed the drive.
